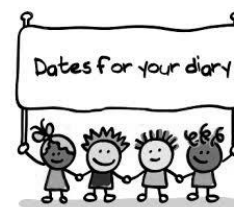

## Primary 7 Residential Trip

As a cluster we have been looking at ways to support transition and promote more collegiate working between schools. As part of these discussions we have decided to organise a joint residential trip for all our P7 pupils in the Mearns Cluster in September 2018. This would allow children to meet others of the same age from different schools at the start of P7 and hopefully will foster positive relationships which can be built on throughout the year. As this is a change to our current model we will of course consult with both parents and pupils after the trip to consider whether this is something which we should continue for future years.

## School uniform

The children have all returned looking incredibly smart in their school uniform, thank you. School uniform can still be purchased from Tesco. Please remember to name all your child's belongings. Children should have a gym kit in school at all times. This should be kept in a gym bag and hung on your child's peg. Gym kits will be sent home once a term to be laundered.

A reminder that Education Scotland have an expectation that all children should be fully involved in outdoor education and promote the use of outdoor experiences at every opportunity within the school day. **We would, therefore, expect the children to be appropriately dressed at all times for the Scottish climate.** As we also plan to continue the Daily Mile initiative can I please remind pupils to make sure they have appropriate footwear and clothing for running in all weather☺!!
