

Our topic is ...

This term we are continuing with our toys theme but will be investigating different forces toys use.

We will be finding out how some toys work and finding out about what makes them move.

We will also be thinking about how to keep safe around toys. Tidy toys away, keep your bedroom tidy, no trip hazards!

Main outcomes to be covered this term...

Maths

In maths we will be practising our addition skills as well as learning about place value, estimating and measure.

We are exploring the seasons, learning our days of the week, months of the year and discussing day and night as well as looking at clocks. Talking about time at home can support your child to understand these everyday skills.

Literacy

This term we will continue exploring initial sounds and how we can make simple three letter words using these sounds. We will continue with our blends and spelling to help us with our reading and writing. We will also be learning how to write a simple report to discuss our findings and thoughts. We are looking forward to sharing our show and tell information and supporting each other to gain confidence and skills when presenting in front of others.

Health and Wellbeing.

This term our focus is to keep ourselves safe around fireworks and make sure when playing with toys we reduce the risks of accidents. We will be talking about keeping toys tidy so we do not fall over them and also looking at electrical gadgets and toys and how we ensure they are working properly and made from safe materials.
