Our topic is ...

This term we will have two mini topics. These will be looking at the impact people in the past and inventions have had on our lives. Primary 3's will look at individual inventors such as Alexander Graham Bell.

We will also be learning about different types of forces. We will be carrying out different experiments to see how a force can change the speed, direction or shape of an object. We will also be exploring magnets and how they work.

Main outcomes to be covered this term...

Maths

This term we will be learning about numbers and place value. We will be looking at the value of numbers and how we can represent numbers visually using differing concrete materials. Some pupils will be looking at numbers before, after and in between. Some within 10 and some within 20. Others will be looking at 10/100 more than and less than within 1000. We are also looking at different 2D and 3D shapes. We will be looking at their properties and what 3D nets look like. We will also be learning about both shape and number sequences.

Literacy

The 'Bees' are working hard on learning our initial sounds. We're having great fun learning the actions and songs to go along with our sounds.

The 'Ladybirds' and 'Butterflies' are now working on putting two letters together to make a single sound e.g. 'oo.' They are also working on recognising and spelling some Tricky Words.

The 'Spiders' are continuing to learn more complex and tricky sounds. They are working hard on developing their story telling within their writing using interesting adjectives and WOW words.

Health and Well being

This term we will have three main social focusses within play. We have been thinking about how we do these well and what they look like. They are listening, sharing and verbal communication.

We are also continuing to learn about how to keep ourselves safe in different situations.

This term in PE we will be working with Mrs Sutherland on gymnastics. They will also have Art with Ms Gatherum who will be doing poly printing with them. They will also be focussing on different facial features and where they are positioned. On a Thursday they have Kodaly.
