School Improvement Priorities

We continue to focus on the following school improvement priorities: -

Raising Attainment and Achievement

- Making Thinking Visible approaches to be shared with staff through twilight sessions
- Mastery in Maths workshops
- Cluster working groups including staff from Mearns Academy to look at the curriculum across Primary and Secondary sectors.
- Dyslexia training to be completed by all staff by Feb in-service

Social and Emotional Wellbeing

- 'When the adult changes, everything changes' Paul Dix staff continue to engage in reading and discussion
- First Aid training for all on Feb in-service

Assessment of Children's Progress/Parental Engagement

- Staff are working with colleagues from Redmyre, Marykirk and St Cyrus to moderate children's progress in listening and talking
- Pupils are becoming more confident in using 'Seesaw' to demonstrate their understanding and share their learning at home
- Written progress reports will be issued to each child and face to face parent consultations in March
