#### **Challenge (optional)**

Temperature is the measure of warmth - How hot or cold something is. Temperature is measured using a device called a thermometer. A thermometer is a long thin tube that is filled with liquid mercury. The mercury will rise when the temperature is hot, and fall when the temperature is cold. How Is Temperature Measured?
