Living and non-living things


Watch the video about 'Living and non-living things'. How many living things can you find at home or in the garden? And how many non-living things? Make a list!

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Challenge (optional)

Temperature is the measure of warmth - How hot or cold something is. Temperature is measured using a device called a thermometer. A thermometer is a long thin tube that is filled with liquid mercury. The mercury will rise when the temperature is hot, and fall when the temperature is cold.

How Is Temperature Measured?

Temperature is measured with three different scales, but we will focus in:

- Celsius: The most common form of measuring temperature in day-to-day situations.
