<p>Arts -</p> <p>Window in your house</p> <p>Choose a window in your house and look outside at what you see. Make a drawing of something you are looking at. It could be just one thing like a car, a tree, a garden shed or a person. Perhaps you would like to try to draw the whole view outside the window.</p> <p>Begin by drawing the window frame on your paper. Remember to make it as big as the size of the paper you have, so that the frame of the window is at the edges of the paper. Once you have done this, look out of the window at what you see.
